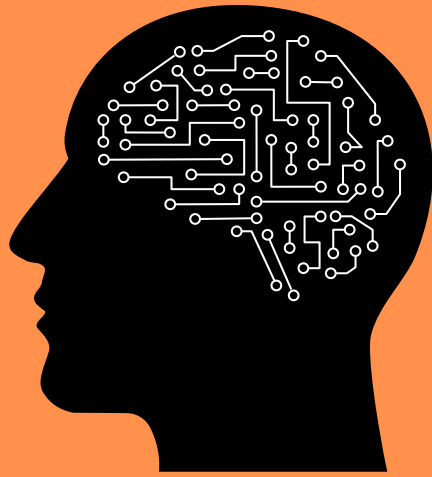

aphasia?**

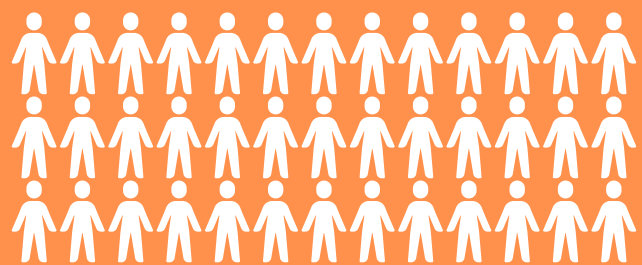
a·pha·sia
