The Aphasia Reading Group gathers to read aloud and discuss topics of interest to adults. Topics range from *The American Red Cross* to *Our National Parks*. The reading theme is e-mailed to group members before each meeting giving individuals a chance to become familiar with the topic and vocabulary.

Group members take turns reading aloud sentences and answering multiple choice questions. We end each session with ***“What do you think?”*** questions which promote discussion of the topic.

Supportive prompting is provided by volunteer speech-language pathologists, college students in training, and fellow group members. We encourage both readers and non-readers to attend the sessions.
